
































My Favourite Protein - Enzymes

I don't think anyone has ever said something like this before. I mean, a favourite protein, seriously? But hear me out! Enzymes are so fascinating. An enzyme is a protein that speeds up the rate of any chemical reaction. They are known as biocatalysts, but I call them molecular matchmakers. They possess a supernatural ability to play cupid for molecules. Each enzyme seeks out its perfect substrate match, accelerating growth, and leading to a very successful career of speeding up chemical reactions. It's almost like a tale of biochemical love at first sight-definitely a book I'd read. Another really good analogy I came up with is that enzymes are the head chefs at a restaurant that work with only certain specific ingredients. Each dish, which I'd like to think of as a chemical reaction, requires specific ingredients (substrates) and cooking techniques (catalysis). Just like how the chef combines these ingredients to create a finger-licking gourmet meal with expertise, enzymes bring together molecules to speed up reactions. The chef is always ready to cook more of these gourmet meals; similarly, these enzymes can be reused to fulfil their function in the human body. Now, that was just a sneaky way to get you to understand how enzymes work as catalysts to speed up reactions in the body. The real reason why enzymes are my favourite protein is simply that they remind me of Pac-Man, a game I loved to play back in primary school.
